Our students won 4 awards at the Inventors Fair, 7 awards at the Regional Science Fair and 5 Awards at the Coding Tournament!

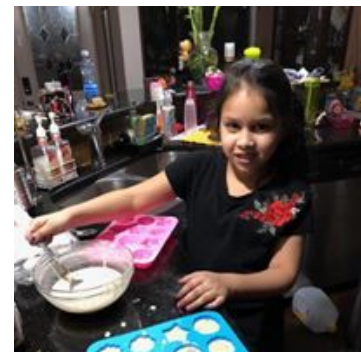
Our Girls Basketball team won the Christina Gordon Cup and the Boys got 3rd in the city Volleyball tournament!
