- 1) Review and Approve Agenda
- 2) Bullying Presentation by Constable Kendal-Coveny
 - a. Bullying is a pattern of repeated aggressive behavior with negative intent directed from 1 person to another where there is a power imbalance. This could be physical, perceived intellectual, age, employer/employee, husband/wife.
 - b. Bullying for adults turns into criminal harassment
 - c. Types: physical, verbal, social, cyber
 - d. Physical aggression is assault
 - e. Verbal aggression is to or about sexist, racist, threatening, hurtful and unkind
 - f. Social alienation is to exclude or embarrass
 - g. Cyberbullying using tech to hurt
 - h. WITS Using this approach there's a 50/50 chance the behavior will stop with the first two steps, the person will lose interest and stop
 - i. Why do people bully see it at home, see other kids doing it, seems cool, for emulation
 - j. Criminal harassment escalated to point someone is fearing for their safety – has to be repeated behavior -stalking
