- 2. Review meeting's Agenda
- 3. School update regarding the Government's new Health Restrictions
- Grades 7-12 will move to online learning
- Grades ECDP-6 will break for Christmas on December 21st, 2020 and will have an additional week off which will move to online learning commencing on January 4th, 2021 to January 8th, 2020 and they will return to school on January 11th, 2020
- Staff are having a PD Day on December 4th, 2020 where their focus will be on what online learning will consist of

 - 6. Fundraising
 - Society was disappointed at the lack of input from Parents and Teachers with the Cookbook efforts
